The Bee Network in Rochdale Castleton-Rochdale Walking and Cycling Corridor

What is the Bee Network?

It is Greater Manchester's vision to create an integrated London-style transport system which will join together buses, trams, rail as well as cycling and walking.

The vision is to create the perfect neighbourhood and the Bee Network will connect up every area and community in Greater Manchester, making it easy, safe and attractive for people to ride, scoot, walk or wheel and will create a transport system that joins up buses, trams, cycling, walking and rail.

The scheme will make trips by foot and bike a safe, pleasant experience, contributing to the delivery of the UK's largest cycling and walking network.

Progress

Phase I of the Cycleway scheme continues to progress well along Manchester Road towards Castleton.

The Toby Hotel side of Manchester Road is at maximum length now for Phase I, and works will commence on the opposite side of the road from Monday 21st November. This will start at the Toby Hotel end of the scheme and advance towards Nixon Street up until Christmas 2022.

The development of Nixon Street car park is on schedule and will open for public parking prior to Christmas 2022.

Christmas Shutdown

Construction Industry Christmas Holiday Shutdowns dictate that we will be vacating site between the 21^{st} December 2022 and the 5^{th} January 2022.

Prior to the 21st December, we will remove all traffic and pedestrian management as is practically possible before we close down for the Christmas Holidays.
