

What is the Bee Network?

It is Greater Manchester's vision to create an integrated London-style transport system which will join together buses, trams, rail as well as cycling and walking.

The vision is to create the perfect neighbourhood and the Bee Network will connect up every area and community in Greater Manchester, making it easy, safe and attractive for people to ride, scoot, walk or wheel will create a transport system that joins up buses, trams, cycling, walking and rail.

The scheme will make trips by foot and bike a safe, pleasant experience, contributing to the delivery of the UK's largest cycling and walking network.

Progress



Phase two is now well underway and progress is as per the planned programmes. The lighter, brighter days are helping enormously with progress as well as the warmer/drier days too.

Over the next few weeks you will start to see completion of the new footpath surface course and cycleway surface course (buff colour) in phase one which will really bring everything together.



New turfing works will also be carried out on Manchester Road adjacent the parking lay by opposite the Toby.

Phase two is running concurrently with phase one and we expect this phase to be complete by 11th May 2023.

All new carriageway re-surfacing works will now be undertaken in the summer months which is much more amenable when laying shiny new tarmac.
