

What is the Bee Network?

It is Greater Manchester's vision to create an integrated London-style transport system which will join together buses, trams, rail as well as cycling and walking.

The vision is to create the perfect neighbourhood and the Bee Network will connect up every area and community in Greater Manchester, making it easy, safe and attractive for people to ride, scoot, walk or wheel will create a transport system that joins up buses, trams, cycling, walking and rail.

The scheme will make trips by foot and bike a safe, pleasant experience, contributing to the delivery of the UK's largest cycling and walking network.

Road Closures

The current road closures at Royle Barn Road will be removed on Thursday 6th April 2023 and Keswick Street will be removed on Friday 14th April 2023.



Partington Street will be closed from Tuesday 11th April 2023 until 21st April 2023.

Progress

Over the next few weeks you will start to see completion of the new footpath surface course and cycleway surface course (buff colour) in phase one which will really bring everything together.

New turfing works is also being carried out on Manchester Road adjacent the parking lay by opposite the Toby.



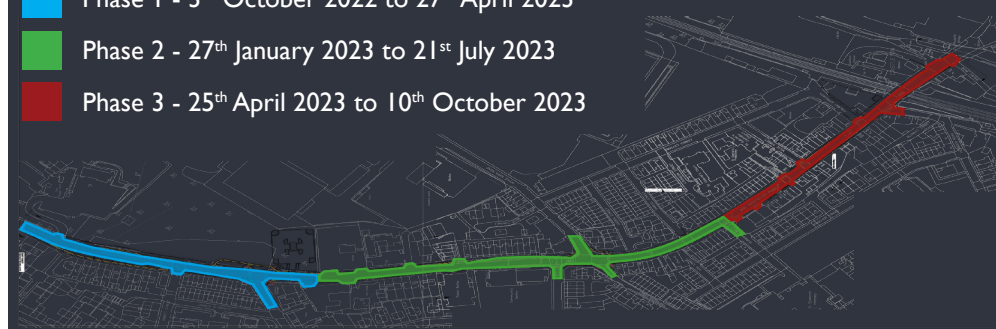
Phase two is running concurrently with phase one and we expect this phase to be completed by 27th July 2023. Progress is being helped enormously now that we are in Spring and the days are becoming lighter, warmer and dryer.

All new carriageway re-surfacing works will now be undertaken in the summer months which is much more amenable when laying shiny new tarmac.

- Phase 1 - 3rd October 2022 to 27th April 2023
- Phase 2 - 27th January 2023 to 21st July 2023
- Phase 3 - 25th April 2023 to 10th October 2023
