Three major junction improvements will be completed on behalf of Trafford Council, taking us to Spring 2024

The project will see these junctions undergoing major reconfiguration into cycle friendly cyclops junctions including all new smart signals to cut down on unnecessary waiting, bike lanes and remodelling of traffic islands. Talbot Road is very busy and local cyclists must use this area to get to other places. These works will make it easier and safer to use and improve. The three junction improvements will see the creation of a safe continuous cycling and walking link through the centre of Trafford opening the area up for active travel, improving safety and taking cars off the road.

Progress

Significant effort has been made jointly by Trafford Council's and our own Project teams to publicise the works and coordinate with the major events which take place in and around the junctions, not least, Manchester United home fixtures, the T20 England Cricket match, a British Cycling Tour and in Mid-October the Manchester half-marathon runs through the junction.

Works to remodel the paths are underway and the road is planned to be resurfaced under night-time operations around mid-November 2023.

Planned work

Work to remodel the Chester Road junction of Talbot Road is planned to commence in the first week of November.

Local residents and businesses will continue to be informed by the issue of a monthly update, along with the local OTP X feed and Trafford Council website.
