Three major junction improvements will be completed on behalf of Trafford Council, taking us to Spring 2024:

- White City Way
- Great Stone Road
- Chester Road

The project will see these junctions undergoing major reconfiguration into cycle friendly cyclops junctions including all new smart signals to cut down on unnecessary waiting, bike lanes and remodelling of traffic islands. Talbot Road is very busy and local cyclists must use this area to get to other places. These works will make it easier and safer to use. The three junction improvements will see the creation of a safe continuous cycling and walking link through the centre of Trafford opening the area up for active travel, improving safety and taking cars off the road.

Progress

Works on the junction of White City Way with Talbot Road are progressing well. The new pedestrian islands are nearing completion and over the next few weeks the road surface will be replaced using night time operations to minimise the disruption to traffic. Any noisy work will be done soon after we start work so we don't disrupt our neighbours. Work will then take place to lay final surfaces to footways and cycleways.

Planned work

Construction has commenced at the intersection of Chester Road and Talbot Road as scheduled. The focus of the work leading up to Christmas is on Talbot Road, involving the removal of some existing islands and the preparation of the groundwork for the upcoming layout changes.
