The ambitious regeneration project aims to create an attractive event space and enhance public area's in the heart of St Annes. Increasing events in the town centre will lead to more footfall from visitors and residents with the long term goal of generating economic activity. The event space is part of the St Annes Masterplan, which has been designed to improve the look and feel of the town centre, promote public transport and enhance the character of the conservation area.

April's Milestones: Progress Made

- The installation of the second bus shelter on the northern bus layby is now complete with signage and timetables to shortly follow.
- Completed carriageway base reconstruction and bench foundations.
- Kerbing laid on the south side.
- Paving foundations to be completed in coming weeks.
- A number of bus stops along St Thomas' Rd now have raised platforms to allow for better access.

May Focus: Upcoming Work

- Residents will begin to see new paving following completion of foundation works.
- A tall container will be placed within the existing site boundary, containing the bonding material needed for the new block paving.
