## St Annes Event Space

The ambitious regeneration project aims to create an attractive event space and enhance public area's in the heart of St Annes. Increasing events in the town centre will lead to more footfall from visitors and residents with the long term goal of generating economic activity. The event space is part of the St Annes Masterplan, which has been designed to improve the look and feel of the town centre, promote public transport and enhance the character of the conservation area.

### May's Milestones: Progress Made

- Foundations for pedestrian walkways have been completed allowing paving to commence from the western end.
- New kerb lines have been completed forming the new highway layout and pedestrian walkways.

### June's Focus: Upcoming Work

- Works are progressing on the improvements to the bus shelter on the southern side of The Square. Subject to third party service providers, we hope to re-open the bus stop next week. Thank you to all passengers for their patience.
- The aim for June is now to push forward with the paving, allowing everyone to start to witness the transformation of The Square.

### Landscaping

An important part of the scheme is to refresh existing planting, so you will start to see new flowers, grasses and trees in The Square. The existing areas are to be enhanced by filling in current gaps using a mix of new plants. The planting palette has been designed by BDP Landscape Architects using coastal and salt tolerant species, whilst choosing plants that can survive our coastal patterns.
