

Project Update

St Mary's Gate Realm Improvement Scheme

The purpose of the scheme is to improve the active travel facilities such as walking and cycling and public realm along the A58 St Mary's Gate. The scheme involves a series of highway improvement works to provide controlled walking and cycling crossing points connecting Lower Falinge to Rochdale Town Centre.

Completed Activities - March 2025

March was a busy month on site with the completion of the footpaths, new buff surfacing to the cycleways and resurfacing the road.

The new pedestrian crossing is installed but not yet switched on, however, there is a temporary signal controlled crossing installed as a temporary measure. This has meant that the subway can be shut whilst we re-model the walls to make it less "enclosed".

Planned Activities - March 2025

Works are now substantially complete, with only the pedestrian guardrail, signs and bollards to be installed. There will also be a "skeleton crew" on site for the next couple of weeks, completing any minor outstanding and snagging work.

This will mean the traffic management can be lifted, re-opening Redcross St and removing the need to close lanes.

We will also continue with the works to the subway, which should be completed this month, but this will not need any traffic management on the main road.
